



SCHEME OF SERVICE

Duration: 1 year (Renewable upon satisfactory performance)

Position Title: Technical Director

Department: Technical Directorate

Reporting To: Director/CEO

Overall Purpose: The Director of Technical Directorate is responsible for providing strategic leadership and technical expertise to oversee regulatory activities and licensing operations within the Regulation and Licensing sector in Mauritius. He/She will develop and implement regulatory policies, ensure compliance with relevant standards and guidelines, and foster collaboration with stakeholders to achieve regulatory objectives.

Duties:

1. Formulate, implement, and monitor technical standards, codes, guidelines, and best practices for the regulation of utility services.
2. Ensure on the adequacy of licensing processes for utility providers.
3. Ensure adherence to technical standards, safety protocols, and environmental guidelines through regular audits, inspections and investigations of utility services.
4. Advise the Director/CEO on Board and policy development, strategic planning, and regulatory frameworks to enhance the quality and sustainability of utility services.
5. Oversee technical investigations into complaints, accidents, and incidents involving utility services and recommend corrective measures as necessary.
6. Liaise with utility providers, government agencies, and international bodies to promote compliance and share best practices in utility management.

7. Participate in research, innovation, and development of projects to improve the efficiency, safety, and sustainability of utility services.
8. Deliver on the statutory functions of the Authority subject to the relevant Utility legislations.
9. Keep abreast of global trends, emerging technologies, and best practices in the utility sector to inform on policy development and technical standards.
10. Ensuring compliance with statutory requirements pertaining to wayleave determination.
11. Perform such other cognate duties as may be assigned by the Director/CEO.

Salary: Negotiable and will commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Probation: 3 months

Qualifications and Experience:

- Should be Electrical Engineers or Electronic Engineers or Mechanical Engineers or Mechatronics Engineer or Electrical and Electronic Engineers who are Registered Professional Engineers with the Council of Registered Professional Engineers of Mauritius under section 13 of the Registered Professional Engineers Council Act No. 49 of 1965, and as subsequently amended.
- Possess a Master's Degree in the field of Engineering or Management.
- Reckon at least 10 years of post-registration experience in regulatory affairs or licensing or technical management, preferably within a regulated industry.
- Demonstrated leadership skills, with experience managing multidisciplinary teams and complex projects.
- Excellent communication, negotiation, and stakeholder engagement skills.
- Knowledge of regulatory frameworks, standards, and best practices in Mauritius.
- Proficiency in IT.

Note: Non-citizens wishing to apply for the position, and if selected, will be required to register with the Council of Registered Professional Engineers of Mauritius.
