Labour Day – Concert on Friday 01 May 2026

By virtue of authority conferred upon me by Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made in Port Louis on Friday 01 May 2026 as from 1800 hours to 2300 hours in connection with the Labour Day – Concert which will be held in front of the City Council of Port Louis.

2. Closure of Road

- (iii) Vehicles coming from the direction of Plaine Verte and proceeding towards Motorway, when reaching junction SSR Street and Sir William Newton Street, will be diverted on contraflow onto Sir William Newton Street and Remy Ollier then onto Jules Koenig Street;
- (iv) Vehicles coming from the direction of Plaine Verte and proceeding towards Champ de Mars, when reaching junction SSR Street and Sir William Newton Street, will be diverted onto Sir William Newton Street then onto Dauphine Street; and
- (v) Vehicles motoring along Sir William Newton Street and proceeding towards Champ de Mars, when reaching junction Sir William Newton Street and Remy Ollier Street, will be diverted onto Remy Ollier Street then onto Bourbon Street.

4. Reverse Street

Sir William Newton Street from its junction with Remy Ollier Street and SSR Street and Remy Ollier Street from its junction with Jules Koenig Street and Sir William Newton Street.

5. No Parking Zone

All closed roads will be a No Parking Zone.

6. Judicial Proceedings

Non-compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.

General Notice No. 473 of 2026

THE UTILITY REGULATORY AUTHORITY

THE ELECTRICITY ACT
(Sections 26 and 28(4)(a))

ELECTRICITY TARIFFS (TEMPORARY CHARGES) – 2026

1. In the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 26 and 28(4)(a) of the Electricity Act, the Utility Regulatory Authority hereby fixes the prices, as specified hereunder, to be charged for the supply of electricity.
2. The price that shall be charged by the Central Electricity Board (the “Board”) for the electricity services to residential consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix I.
3. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to residential consumers who have installed electric chargers solely for the purpose of charging electric cars shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix I.
4. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the electricity services to commercial consumers and bulk consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix II.
5. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the electricity services to industrial consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix III.
6. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the supply to a bulk consumer in the light rail industry shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix III and shall be subject to revision in January of each calendar year.
7. The price that shall be charged by the Board during any particular month for the electricity services to sugar factories requiring standby supply for starting the factory and emergency supply during the crop season shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix IV.
8. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the electricity services to tariffs applicable to municipal, district and village councils for street lighting purposes, beach authority for public lighting, Mauritius Police Force for speed cameras and CCTV cameras and for traffic lights during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix V.
9. The price that shall be charged by the Board during any particular month for the electricity services to an Industrial Consumer for pumping for irrigation purposes only shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix VI.
10. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the electricity services for temporary purposes shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix VII.

11. The price that shall be charged by the Board for electricity services to residential prosumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with Tariffs set out in Appendix VIII.

12. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the supply to other prosumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in the relevant Appendices.

13. The price that shall be charged by the Board for meter rental during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix IX, which shall remain unchanged from those previously approved.

14. The Tariffs for the commercial prosumers, the industrial prosumers, the residential prosumers and the other prosumers shall not apply to prosumers registered with the Board as distributed generators prior to August 2015.

15. The Tariffs applicable under this Notice shall not apply to –

- (a) consumers registered under Tariff 110A (Social Register of Mauritius);
- (b) consumers under Tariff Categories 215 and 315;
- (c) small and medium enterprises (SMEs), as applicable; and
- (d) any other category as may be specified in the Appendices

16. The tariffs set out in all Appendices, other than Appendix IX, reflect an adjustment not exceeding fifteen per cent (15%) applied within the existing approved tariff structure, to the extent necessary to partially address increased electricity generation costs, except for the categories specified under paragraph 14.

17. For the avoidance of doubt –

- (a) no adjustment to security deposits or related charges is included in this Notice;
- (b) no new tariff categories or schemes are introduced; and
- (c) no restructuring of existing tariffs is effected.

18. All bills shall be rounded to the nearest rupee.

19. The tariffs fixed under this Notice are authorised as temporary charges pending a final tariff determination.

20. The revised tariffs shall take effect as from 1 May 2026.

21. For accounting purposes, electricity bills issued in respect of consumption related to meter readings taken on 1 May 2026 and until 31 May 2026 shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis. For the sake of this calculation, each day's consumption shall be deemed to be the equivalent of 1/31st of the total consumption registered on the meter since the date of the last reading.
